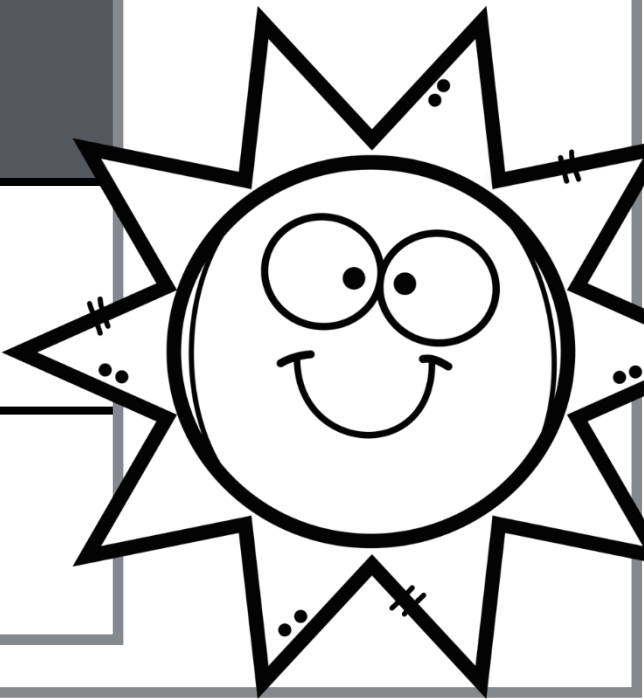


All About Summer
